RULES and POLICIES FOR POOL:

These rules and policies are set forth to provide ALL residents and members with a safe and welcoming environment. All persons using the pool do so at their own risk and agree to abide by the rules and policy for this facility. Pool Management staff has the right to dismiss any person not complying with the rules and policies. Any privileges to use the facility may be denied to anyone who does not act in accordance with these rules. Proper respect and cooperation is due to the lifeguards, who are to provide for the safe and orderly operation of the pool. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated while rules are being enforced.

- 1. No persons shall use the pool unless it is officially opened with a lifeguard on duty.
- 2. All users must have a pool pass. Residents will need to re-register these passes for

- future years. Registration is completed digitally via our community app. All children younger than 13 will be issued a child pass (2 years or younger exempt).
- 3. Guests may be admitted if authorized and accompanied by residents. Each resident using the pool that day is allowed to bring in one guest. Residents are responsible for their children and their guests at all times.
- 4. Proper attire for swimming is required. No street clothes are permitted. Children not toilet trained must wear a swim diaper in either pool.
- 5. All children under the age of 6 or who are not able to swim must have the adult present/in the water with the child. **Lifeguards do not monitor the wading pool.** Parents, please monitor your older children if they are using the wading pool to ensure the youngest children are not scared or harmed in any way. Rough play will not be allowed.
- 6. Children younger than 13 must be accompanied by a parent or approved supervisor (16+ years) and must remain with them during the entire time they are in the pool area.
- 7. Smoking, alcoholic beverages and glass drink containers are prohibited.
- 8. Food may be consumed in a designated area on the pool deck. Residents and guests must dispose of all refuse in containers provided for this purpose. Keeping the facility clean is everyone's responsibility.
- 9. No Pets are permitted.
- 10. Radios and CD players may be played only with earphones, at a volume that does not disturb others.
- 11. Game playing and the use of floats are allowed at the discretion of the lifeguards. Diving, running, horseplay, profane language, and disruptive conduct around the pool are strictly forbidden. Anyone performing these behaviors will be asked to leave the facility. Continue disturbance will result in lost facility privileges.
- 12. No wheel vehicles or strollers are allowed in pool area. (Under certain circumstances if an infant requires it, strollers may be allowed. It must be monitored closely by an adult, 21 or older, and is at the discretion of Pool Management to deny the use for abuse or safety reasons.)
- 13. Chairs may not be reserved.
- 14. Private pool parties are prohibited.
- 15. The pool may be closed at any time due to weather (rain, thunder, lightning, etc.), breakdown of equipment, operational defects or other unavoidable causes.
- 16. Residents with open lesions or sores are not permitted to use the pool.
- 17. Patrons must shower before entering the pool area. Please make use of the provided locker room for all bags and non-swim attire.
- 18. The lifeguards may demand any patron leave the pool area if the rules are not being followed.

DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:

The Association and its Board of Directors, the Managing Agent of the Association, and the employees, agents or servants of these entities shall be held harmless from any and all claims, liabilities and other action by any Owner, and by any guests, tenants, or licensees of any Owner, arising from, or the result of, any accident, injury or other occurrence which causes loss or damage to life, limb or property sustained in connection with, or as a consequence of, the use of the pool, except when such is clearly proved to have resulted from, and have been

proximately caused by, the direct negligence in the operation, care, or maintenance of the pool and pool deck area by the entities or individuals cited in this paragraph.

Any damage to the pool caused by any Owner and by any guest, tenant, or licensee of any Owner, may be repaired by the Association at the expense of the Owner, as determined by the Association.
